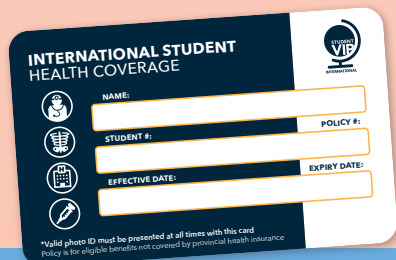
Your card has been e-mailed to you. However, you can also access your card anytime by following the steps below.

(*cards available in October)

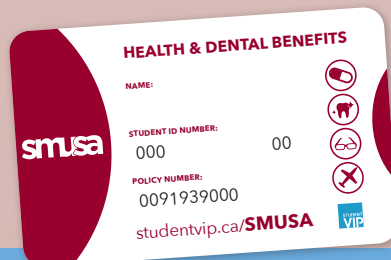
